European Space Agency (ESA) is in charge of the deployment of the Galileo system and the technical operations.

The **European GNSS Service Centre (GSC)**, under the responsibility of the GSA, offers users a one-stop-shop web portal that provides Galileo users with relevant information on the system's status and easy access to a dedicated Helpdesk. Today it provides a single interface for the Galileo Open Service(OS) and Commercial Service (CS) user communities.
